Dear Friends,

Seldom does the ordinary person make the connection between their religious or spiritual beliefs and how to bring all that into the workplace, failing to make the connection between what they hold as spiritual values and their work day, as well as their present and future goals.

Most compartmentalize their lives, seeing their spirituality separate from their relationships, their family, their home and possessions, their career, their goals, their future happiness, their earning capabilities and all their responsibilities.

In this attempt to separate one aspect of life from another, we can find ourselves isolated and confused, never quite satisfied, never quite catching the brass ring.

Even though we attempt to be so, we are not compartmentalized beings. At our center we are one. Therefore our relationship with God has everything to do with our relationships, our families, our homes and possessions, our careers, our goals, our future happiness, our earning capabilities and all our responsibilities.

God and spirituality are not to be tucked away, to be pulled out only on Sunday or when we sit on our meditation cushion. Our spiritual awareness and awakening has everything to do with everything in our lives.

A vitally important spiritual law that is the cornerstone of an awakened consciousness is coming to know God as the Source of all your good, all your blessings, all your abundance.

To bring this teaching into tangible, practical application, I am going to be presenting a number of Sunday lessons beginning March 14 with the underlying themes: "What would Jesus do?" "What would Buddha do?"

The greatest teachings of the two of them readily apply to real-life challenges, as they offer spiritual formulas for practical solutions.
